This guide outlines a path for degree completion at Webster University for a Bachelor of Arts in Interactive Digital Media for students entering with an Associate of Applied Science degree in Web Development & Administration from Southwestern Illinois College. Students are strongly encouraged to meet with a Webster University transfer admissions counselor early in their academic career to ensure a smooth transfer experience.

ABOUT INTERACTIVE DIGITAL MEDIA MAJOR AT WEBSTER

In the BA in interactive digital media, students learn a systematic and thorough approach to the study of interactive media. Students learn interactive production skills, including web and interactive programming, graphic design, and audio and video production. Students learn to integrate different media into several different types of interactive experiences that effectively communicate whatever the objective of the project is.

- x Transfer students should not expect to obtain a degree in the Department of Electronic and Photographic Media in less than four full semesters of sequenced courses.
- x Students must earn a grade of C or better in any course they wish to apply toward their major or general education/GCP
- x Most students who major in the School of Communications must complete a portfolio review as a requirement for graduation. While the majority of work students will exhibit for this review should come from assignments in their courses at Webster University, students may also include exceptional work they have completed at other

institutions and therefore the departments suggest incoming transfer students save any such work they deem appropriate for the portfolio review. Any questions about the portfolio review process should be directed to their academic advisor.

- x Webster University provides full transfer coursework successfully completed as part of an associate degree awarded by a regionally accredited institution. While students with associate
