TRANSFER GUIDELINES

- Students who have completed the St. Louis County and Municipal Police Academy must submit an official transcript [Individual Basic Recruit Record Graduate] with academy graduation date.
- Students matriculating at Webster University may be eligible to receive 27 credit hours of transfer credit at the lower division, baccalaureate level.
 - Per university attended and meet all other admissions requirements.
